

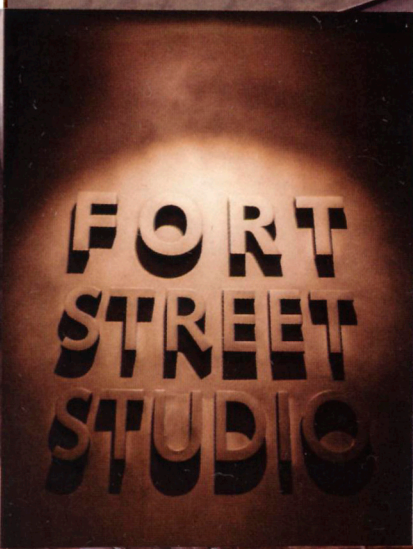

Fort Street Studio

The luxury carpet manufacturer unveils a new 5,000-square-foot flagship in One Island South, a new grade-A office building in Wong Chuk Hang, Hong Kong. Twice the size of its previous location, the store was designed by SLINC in conjunction with Brad Davis. To mark the opening, Fort Street debuts new designs, with a few departing from the studio's signature wild-silk content and venturing into wool—like the undulating waves of **Slide**, in Dijon or gray wool pile. Combining the two yarns is the abstracted botanical **Lotus**, in pale; also available in the colorway smoke, in 100 percent wool. An all-silk option is **Cavern**, with a mysterious ring floating in the murky depths of its 100 percent wild Dandong silk. 212-925-5383; fortstreetstudio.com.
